# Pinetop-Lakeside P&Z to Consider 41-acre Mixed-use

In its Jan. 9 meeting, the Pinetop-Lakeside Planning and Zoning Commission will consider a site plan and design review request from A-OK Builders to develop a 41.1-acre parcel at White Mountain Blvd. and Show Low Lake Road.

Rustic Pines will consist of 61 residential units for sale, 163 rental units and 2.58 acres of commercial space. The for-sale units will feature a one-car garage with additional driveway parking. The rental area will have a total of 357 parking spaces.

For-sale units will be available in two- or three-bedroom configurations. The rental units are planned for a mix of 104 two-bedroom and 59 three-bedroom residences. The three-bedroom units will also have individual garages.

Planned amenities include a 3.9KSF clubhouse with a fitness center, men's and women's changing areas, a great room, a small group gathering area, a concierge station and a conference room.

The location had previously been part of the Apache Sitgreaves National Forest but was removed through a previous land exchange. The site was rezoned for light commercial use in 2019.

The development will include a screen wall and fencing along the southeastern edge, according to the staff comments and submitter responses. Plant screening will be installed on the eastern edge.

Construction is planned in a single phase, with infrastructure and roadway work to start first.

Town staff has recommended approval of the project with standard conditions.

### **Skilled Nursing Facility Planned in Mesa**

The **Mesa Design Review Board** recently reviewed and made recommendations on the building elevations and landscape design for a new skilled nursing facility on Main Street east of 56th Street.

The vacant, 2.07-acre property is situated next to a warehouse owned by **Velda Rose Methodist Church**. The submitted narrative states the church is working with the applicant—identified on the landscape plans as **Circle the City**—and the **City of Mesa** to separate the two parcels. Circle the City provides healthcare services to individuals facing homelessness in Maricopa County.

The project will require a site plan and design review. The applicant has also requested a special use permit for a minor reduction in provided parking. Hospitals and skilled nursing homes are allowed uses under the existing limited commercial zoning.

Referred to only as **Skilled Nursing Facility** in the submitted

documents, the location will feature a building of slightly less than 30KSF with 84 patient beds. Total lot coverage is 62.4KSF.

The design features a central courtyard for use by patients and staff. Rooms will be divided into quads, with separate spaces for male and female patients. There will also be four isolation rooms for patients who need to be kept separated for reasons of overall safety or wellbeing.

Other features include "a common dining room, medical exam rooms, office space, staff lockers, laundry, a medical lab, a meeting room, and wound care rooms," according to the narrative.

The narrative also says the Skilled Nursing Facility will have a minimal impact on surrounding properties. "On the north side of the site, there is the Velda Rose Warehouse and an existing residential community further north. The east side of the Property is adjacent to a medical/professional complex and Velda Rose Church. On the west side of the site is the Colonade Motel Suites. The southern boundary is Main Street with a vacant lot on the opposite side of Main Street."

Velda Rose Methodist Church is the current site owner, and Circle the City is the project applicant. **Perlman Architects** is the design firm. Landscape planning is by **McGough Adamson**. The civil engineer is **Civil Design Solutions**, and mechanical/electrical/plumbing engineering is by **KCL Engineering**. **Pew & Lake**, **PLC** is the project representative. •

### **Phoenix Authorizes Funding for Affordable Housing Developments**

Early last month, the **Phoenix City Council** unanimously voted to approve slightly more than \$3M for the development of **Senior Bridge**, a transitional and affordable senior housing development at 2853 E. Van Buren St. north of Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport.

The Council action directs the **City Manager** to enter into an **Affordable Housing Loan Program** agreement for the funding using **U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development HOME Investment Partnerships American Rescue Plan** program funds.

Other funding sources for the development include \$7.1M from the **Arizona Department of Housing**, \$1.95M from **Bloomspot LLC** and \$750K from the **City of Phoenix**, according to the agenda.

The Dec. 4 agenda entry says, "Senior Bridge... consists of 65 permanent supportive housing units for previously homeless seniors entering from Senior Bridge's on-site transitional housing units. The 65 permanent supportive housing units will serve seniors with Area Median Income levels at or below 30%."

A local news outlet <u>reported</u> the Senior Bridge campus will also include 40 one-bedroom transitional housing units.

Senior Bridge will be developed by **Steel + Spark**. According to the article, the development will consist of four 40-foot shipping containers that have been modified for residential use. The containers will be connected into an X shape and will feature solar power by day and battery power by night.

Steel + Spark has built several container-based private developments in the Phoenix area, along with four temporary housing communities of 20 units each.

#### **Other Developments**

The Council's Dec. 4 agenda featured two other projects requesting funding in addition to Senior Bridge.

**Housing for Hope, LLC** requested more than \$3M for its **St. Catherine Manor** development at 1431 E. Southern Ave. According to the agenda, "St. Catherine Manor... consists of 11 permanent

supportive housing units for previously homeless seniors. Eight of the 11 units will be targeted for seniors with Area Median Income levels of less than 30%, and three of the 11 units will be targeted for seniors with AMI levels of less than 60%."

#### **Tanner Community Development**

The agenda also included a request for nearly \$2.67M for the Tanner Thomas Village Affordable Housing Development Project.

According to the entry, "Tanner Thomas Village, located at 1803 E. Broadway Road, consists of 37 permanent supportive housing units for previously homeless veterans. The 37 permanent supportive housing units will serve veterans with Area Median Income levels at or below 30%." •



### **Sedona Considering a Proposed Creekwalk**

A proposal by the Arizona Department of Transportation to sell two parcels of land near State Route 179 and Sombart Lane to the City of **Sedona** could pave the way for a long-envisioned **creekwalk** as part of the local parks and trails system.

Deputy City Manager Andy Dickey informed the City Council about the proposal at a retreat last month and added the land could be used for trails and/or a creek park. The site is located south of a recently completed pedestrian underpass. A future creekwalk could connect between the parcel and the underpass at SR 179.

The other end of the creekwalk could connect to the Ambiente: Creekside hotel in the Uptown area.

Staff is considering advancing the plan in the upcoming fiscal year. The draft plan shows the route running south along Oak Creek's west bank from Ambiente, crossing the creek with a footbridge to the Oak Creek Heritage Lodge and then recrossing past Tlaquepaque down to the ADOT property.

Discussions of Oak Creek-area walking paths and footbridges date back to 1993. In 2014, the creekwalk cost was estimated at \$1.6M and has risen to \$5.5M as of last month. (Source)



### Yuma to Apply for SMART Grants for Infrastructure Projects

On Dec. 18, Yuma City Council authorized the City to apply for Arizona State Match Advantage for Rural Transportation funds for infrastructure projects.

The AZ SMART fund was created in 2022 by the Arizona Legislature. The funds are intended to assist municipalities, counties and the Arizona Department of Transportation to compete for federal grants.

AZ SMART funds are available for federal discretionary grants. The funds are awarded by the discretion of the federal agency and not distributed by formula/allocation. **ADOT** requires applicants to have jurisdictional approval prior to applying for AZ SMART funds.

The Yuma projects would include storm drain upgrades and traffic interchange improvements. The first proposal concerns a traffic interchange at I-8 and Avenue 8½ E. The Arizona Department of Transportation created a Design Concept Report in March of 2000 to consider alternatives for the traffic interchange. The goals of the report were to provide access to North Frontage Road and 32nd Street.

Fiscal limitations would not allow the underpass to be constructed at the time. A partially constructed interchange was created to provide direct access to I-8. The interchange is two decades old. A new Design Concept Report is required to evaluate how to meet travel demands.

An initial proposal for the report was made that carried a total price tag of \$600K. The proposal intended AZ SMART to fund \$480K and the City to fund the remaining \$120K. The City funds were to come from a minimum 20% local match. Council then decided on Dec. 18 to revise the report cost to \$1.5M and remove language surrounding the local match.

If the grant is secured, AZ SMART will fund the entire report.

#### **Hacienda Estates Storm Drainage**

The second project the City is seeking AZ SMART funding for the **Hacienda Estates Stormwater Improvement** project.

In Sept. 2024, the **Flood Mitigation Assistance** grant program notified Yuma the project had been identified as needing further review. Flooding has previously caused property damage within the subdivision. The project would increase the safety of residents in the area and decrease flood insurance costs.


The project is estimated to cost \$5.3M. The **FMA** program would provide the project with nearly \$4M, the City's road tax would provide the project with \$850K, and the AZ SMART funds would cover \$480K. The City funds would include the \$120K needed for the AZ SMART local match requirement.

#### 40th Street from Avenue 6E to Fortuna Road

Roadways along I-8 and 32nd Street have experienced an increase in traffic from the ever-growing development in the Foothills community in eastern Yuma.

The **40th Street Corridor** would be a four-lane, minor arterial roadway to connect the eastern communities to the rest of the city. A Design Concept Report is also being developed to explore other options to ease east-west traffic in the area.

While creating the report, Yuma applied for a \$60M **Multimodal Project Discretionary Grant** that carries a 20% local match of \$15M. The City is now seeking \$10M in AZ SMART funding to assist in the local match. Of the remaining \$5M, the City plans to pay \$4M and **Yuma County** plans to pay \$1M. (<u>Source</u>)

### **Mesa P&Z Approves Fairfield Hotel Plan**

The **Mesa Planning and Zoning Board** has approved a site plan for the 79-room, 44.4KSF **Marriott Fairfield Hotel, Mountain Vista** near US 60 and Signal Butte Road.

Located on 2.2 acres in the **Mountain Vista Marketplace**, the planned four-story hotel will have a height of 56.5 feet. Zoning for the hotel location is limited commercial with a planned area development overlay.

Features include a covered public area with seating, an outdoor pool and 82 parking spaces.

No public opposition was reported following notification of property owners within 500 feet of the proposed location. (Source)

### **Sedona Changes Course on Oak Creek Project Refusal**

Following negotiations to settle a lawsuit, the **Sedona City Council** voted 5-2 last month to undo its previous reversal of a **Planning and Zoning Commission** approval for the **Oak Creek Heritage Lodge** development.

The lodge is planned on 11.58 acres between Oak Creek and Schnebly Hill Road. Planning and Zoning had unanimously approved a development review request last April. Following protests from two local opposition groups, Council reversed the approval in June.

According to local news <u>sources</u>, project owners **Olson Real Estate Group Inc.** and its subsidiary **115 Schnebly LLC** filed litigation in **Yavapai County Superior Court** against the City and several other defendants.

The same news outlet <u>now reports</u> Council reversed itself in its Dec. 10 meeting so it could enter into a settlement agreement with Olson. Under that agreement, Olson will break up a group of buildings on the south side of the site into several smaller buildings, reduce balcony overhangs, add parking spaces, limit the number of event attendees and contribute \$550K toward development of a proposed creekwalk or pedestrian bridge connecting to the property. For its part, Council agreed to reverse the previous refusal, approve Olson's development review and exempt the project from increased development fees. •

### **Queen Creek Extends Closing Date for Mixed-use Project**

The Queen Creek Town Council unanimously voted to extend the closing date of its sale of 8.2 acres of land at the NEC of Ellsworth Loop and E. Ocotillo roads for a mixed-use development called **The** Switchyard.

Creation RE is purchasing the land for \$8.6M. The developer plans to create retail, office and multifamily space on the property.

Originally, the item was featured in the Council's consent agenda but was moved to the regular agenda because of Vice Mayor Leah Martineau's recusal due to a family connection to the project.

In December 2023, Council approved selling 6.8 acres to Creation RE for \$7.4M. The additional 1.4 acres were agreed upon in July 2024. Creation RE released its plans in June 2024.

The Switchyard will cost \$120M and consists of 45KSF of restaurants, retail space, offices and an apartment complex with between 150 and 300 units.



The original terms of the agreement required Creation RE to close the sale by the end of 2024, which was contingent upon receiving building permits. The developer requested a 90-day extension, as it was unable to receive the building permits by the previously agreed upon date. The new closing deadline is March 31.

The extension is split into three 30-day sections. Each extension requires a non-refundable payment of \$75K that will be credited toward the total purchase price.

Construction start has also been moved back to April 1. The developer can push the construction start date back to July 1 without penalty.

Land sale proceeds will be directed to the Town Center fund. The development is currently estimated to generate about \$2.9M in one-time revenues from permit fees, impact/capacity fees and construction sales tax. Once completed, the development is estimated to generate \$500K annually in property tax, sales tax and state-shared revenues.

The commercial section of the project is estimated to generate \$850K in one-time revenues. Once completed, annual revenues are expected to be \$430K. (Source)





### Goodyear Still Hopes for Trader Joe's in GSQ Master Plan Area

Late last year, **RED Development** submitted speculative plans for the portion of Goodyear's **GSQ** master-planned development it is building in partnership with **Globe Corporation**.

The plans show a new specialty grocery store of 13.5KSF and two restaurants with a total of 7.8KSF.

The documents refer to **Trader Joe's** as a potential tenant, but the grocer has not confirmed any plans to locate there.

Goodyear officials have worked for years to attract a Trader Joe's location to the city, following numerous requests from residents for specialty and high-end grocers. Other companies residents want to see include Whole Foods, Sprouts Farmers Market and AJ's Fine Foods.

A City spokesperson confirmed there has been no official announcement and the inclusion of a prospective tenant on preliminary planning documents should not be considered final. (Source)

### **ADOT Updates Major Phoenix-Area Projects for 2025**

The **Arizona Department of Transportation** is looking ahead to starting, continuing or completing construction on several Phoenix-area freeway projects in 2025.

Topping **ADOT**'s list of new construction projects is an extension of **Loop 303** from Van Buren Street south to Maricopa County Highway 85 (MC 85) in the Goodyear area. Here is an overview:

• The Loop 303 project, currently in final design, will provide three freeway lanes in each direction between Van Buren Street and Lower Buckeye Road and two lanes in each direction from Lower Buckeye Road to MC 85. New bridges will carry the freeway over several cross streets and the Union Pacific Railroad. The new stretch of Loop 303 will be built where Cotton Lane currently carries area traffic. Work is scheduled to start by fall 2025 and last approximately three years. More information: <a href="mailto:azdot.gov/L303-MC85-VanBuren">azdot.gov/L303-MC85-VanBuren</a>.

The following are among ADOT's major Phoenix-area freeway projects in 2025:

- Completion of the I-10 Broadway Curve Improvement Project between the I-17 "Split" and Loop 202 by spring. This has been the largest freeway reconstruction project in ADOT's history. Work started in fall 2021. Along with new lanes that already have been added along 11 miles of I-10, crews are finishing elevated ramps providing direct connections at the I-10/State Route 143 interchange. They also will complete two pedestrian/bicyclist bridges and widening the Guadalupe Road bridge over I-10. More information: i10broadwaycurve.com.
- The Loop 101 (Pima Freeway) Improvement Project between Shea Blvd. and Princess Drive/Pima Road in Scottsdale is scheduled for completion by early 2026. Work started in January 2024. The project includes the addition of a lane in each direction within a 4.5-mile work zone. Crews also are converting the Loop 101 interchange at Frank Lloyd Wright Blvd. into a diamond configuration to improve traffic flow. - Completion of the I-17 Improvement Project between Anthem Way and Sunset Point north of Phoenix in late 2025. Work on the 23-mile project started in fall 2022. Crews are nearing completion of third lanes in each direction between Anthem Way and Black Canyon City. Work also continues on the unique 8-mile flex lanes system north of Black Canyon City. - The start of an I-10/Loop 101 Interchange Improvement Project in the West Valley is expected by summer 2025. Work will include construction of new HOV ramps providing I-10/Loop 101 connections to and from the east (downtown Phoenix). Crews also will modify the existing southbound Loop 101 to eastbound I-10 ramp to add a direct "exit ramp" to 91st Avenue. A new combined southbound Loop 101 exit to both Thomas and McDowell roads will be built to help manage overall freeway traffic flow. Construction is expected to last two years. - Work will advance on the Loop 101 (Agua Fria Freeway)
   Widening Project between I-17 and 75th Avenue in the northwest Valley. The two-and-a-half-year project started in September 2024. In addition to adding new Loop 101 lanes in each direction, the project includes interchange and cross-street improvements at 75th Avenue. More information: azdot.gov/Loop101West75thToi17.
- The Loop 202 (Santan Freeway) Widening Project between Loop 101 (Price Freeway) and Val Vista Drive in the southeast Valley, which started in Aug. 2024, will add new lanes in each direction. Bridge and interchange improvements are also underway. The project is scheduled for completion by early 2027. More information: azdot.gov/L202-L101-to-ValVista.
- Construction of new I-10 Gila River bridges southeast of Riggs Road will advance during 2025. Crews started work in summer 2024 to replace the outdated existing I-10 bridges crossing the Gila River. Completion is scheduled for summer 2026.
- Completion of the I-17 Resurfacing Project between Happy Valley Road and State Route 74 in north Phoenix by March 2025.
   The project, which started in May has included diamond grinding

of the freeway's concrete pavement surface. ADOT also is finalizing plans for an **I-17 resurfacing project between SR 74 and Anthem Way**, scheduled to start by summer 2025.

ADOT plans and constructs new freeways, additional lanes and other improvements in the Phoenix area as part of the **Regional Transportation Plan** for the Maricopa County region. Many projects are funded in part by **Proposition 400**, a dedicated sales tax approved by Maricopa County voters in 2004. Voters in November approved **Proposition 479**, extending the existing half-cent tax to fund future transportation projects in the Phoenix region. (Source)

### **Pinal County Announces Zoning Update Comment Period**

In order to better serve residents, **Pinal County** is announcing the notice of a 90-day public review draft for the **Pinal County Zoning Ordinance**. This is the first comprehensive revision of the Zoning Ordinance since 2012 and represents a complete update and modernization of the Zoning Ordinance.

"The intent here is to make the code relevant to the times that we're in today," said Pinal County Community Development Associate Director Brent Billingley. "We've attempted to make the code more flexible... and to clarify known issues in the code that have existed for years and that have been difficult for folks to understand," he added.

The draft of the code will be made available beginning on Jan. 16, both online and in person at County offices. Comments can be submitted online to the **Community Development/Development Services Department** from Jan. 16 until 5 p.m. on April 15.

"As many comments as we can get, the better," Billingley said.
"We want folks to understand. We want folks to buy into their land use controls in the County. So that we're all in agreement on how to move forward. And that we have the tools in place to have organized growth."

### **Arizona Population Up 6% Since 2020**

Arizona's population has grown 6% since 2020 and is up 1.5% between 2023 and 2024, according to the latest estimates from the U.S. Census Bureau.

The state's total population sits at almost 7.6 million people. Arizona is 10th for percent growth and eighth for numeric growth over the last year, which saw more than 109,000 new resident arrivals.

Nine states added more than 100,000 people each between July 2023 and July 2024. The national population rose 1%, with Texas leading growth and adding 563,000 people. California led additions in the western region with more than 232,500.

Despite California's population gains, it is also one of the primary contributors of new residents to Arizona. In the past decade, 630,000 Californians – 173/day – have relocated to Arizona.

All the state's new residents have made marked contributions to the Arizona economy. The median household income rose from \$72.6K in 2023 to nearly \$76.9K in 2024. Maricopa County, which is the primary home for new arrivals, saw its median household income rise from \$80.7K to \$85.8K.

New tax filers in 2021 and 2022 contributed \$1.8B to Maricopa County, according to **IRS** and Census Bureau information. (Source)

### **Phoenix Among Top 5 for Construction Job Losses**

A recent <u>analysis</u> from **Associated General Contractors of America** reports Phoenix lost 3,700 construction jobs between November 2023 and November 2024, a decline of 3%. Phoenix's decline made it the fourth-highest market in the country for construction job losses.


Tucson lost a total of 100. Nationally, the sector added 10,000 in November, with 65% of markets seeing gains.

Houston led gaining metros in terms of individual positions, adding 16,100 for a 7% increase. Anchorage, Alaska saw the highest percentage increase, rising by 1,800 jobs for a 17% gain. Markets leading losses included New York City and Portland, Ore., dropping 7,800 and 4,200 jobs, respectively, for a loss of 5% in both metros. Sacramento--Roseville, Calif. led in terms of percentage losses, falling 6%, or 4,700 jobs.

**AGC** Chief Economist Ken Simonson noted the longstanding challenge of finding hourly workers in skilled trades, and added the current political landscape could serve to increase the degree of difficulty. He cited the **Census Bureau**'s **American Community Survey**, which reported nearly a third of workers are not native to the U.S.

President-elect Donald Trump's pledge to deport immigrants in the country illegally could hamper construction recruitment, Simonson said.

AGC CEO Jeffrey Shoaf urged federal officials to pass a **Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act** measure and to double funding under the **Carl D. Perkins Vocational & Technical Education Act** to increase resources for vocational training, adding he believes even comparatively small funding increases can add many more workers to the construction labor pool. 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### Non-residential Spending Functionally Flat Year-over-Year



National nonresidential construction spending declined 0.1% in November, according to an Associated Builders and Contractors analysis of data published by the U.S. Census Bureau. On a seasonally adjusted annualized basis, nonresidential spending totaled \$1.234T. On a year-over-year basis, nonresidential construction spending is up 2.8%, approximately flat in inflationadjusted terms.

Spending was down on a monthly basis in eight of the 16 nonresidential subcategories. Private nonresidential spending was unchanged, while public nonresidential construction spending was down 0.2% in November.

"Contractor confidence surged post-election," said **ABC** Chief Economist Anirban Basu. "Many contractors expect a combination of deregulation and tax cuts to support greater activity and profitability going forward, including substantial investment in traditional energy sectors and manufacturing. Still, there are reasons for concern.

"Nonresidential construction spending momentum has all but disappeared, despite an ongoing boom in data center construction (up 43% year over year), largely because project financing costs remain elevated," said Basu. "With inflation remaining stubbornly high and potentially accelerating going forward, interest rates stand to stay higher for longer. Prospective tariff increases threaten to push construction materials prices higher, and shifting immigration policies could expand future worker shortages. Only time will tell whether the recent upswing in optimism will prove justified." (Source)

### U.S. Multifamily Market Expected to Stay Strong in 2025

The multifamily market across the United States seems to be one of the strongest heading into 2025 and is expected to remain one of the most active sectors with new investments.

**Colliers** recently released an investment outlook that cited multifamily as a strong sector due to its already high demand and the entrance of Gen Z into the workforce. High home prices were also cited as one of the driving factors propelling multifamily developments.


Markets with housing shortages are expected to see significant gains, followed by a resurgence in rents. New multifamily construction is expected to slow in the latter-half of 2025, as negative rent growth impacts areas with new multifamily supply.

The report also noted difficulties, particularly those related to operational expenses. Rising insurance costs have become an issue for multifamily owners. Premiums have caused several deals to be repriced or canceled altogether.

Owners are also dealing with skyrocketing prices for labor, materials and utilities. These combined challenges impact profitability and make it difficult for owners and developers to create new projects.

Interest rates are also to make a significant impact in shaping the market. If rates decrease, more capital would be freed for investment. If rates increase, activity may be reduced. Despite this, Colliers is confident the multifamily market will remain strong and continue to attract investors. (Source)





### Commercial Real Estate Industry Dampened by Inconsistent Interest Rate Messaging

The federal government's mixed statements surrounding interest rates have put a damper on the momentum of commercial real estate trading.

Marcus & Millichap's CEO, Hessam Nadji, recently discussed the effect of the Fed's vagueness regarding interest rates during an appearance on Yahoo! Finance. Nadji stated private individual investors, high-net-worth investors and small partnerships are sensitive to interest rates and will wait to sell until favorable values are in place. He also stated these investors own the vast majority of CRE.

Nadji urged the Fed to be clearer in its messaging to give investors a stronger idea of how the market is moving. Currently, it appears as though inflationary caution is beginning to wane, but the pressures are still there.

Values peaked in March 2022 and have been coming down since then. Currently, many investors are paying cash to secure select properties and are waiting for interest rates to come down before financing projects. Nadji also cited the **10-year Treasury**'s yield increase to 4.5% as altering the market's sentiment.

Nadji described market optimism surrounding corrected valuations, steady and stable job growth and limited supply. He also pointed out new developments and construction are expensive, so the supply industry has been cooperating more with developers.

Nadji also touched on the potential impacts of President-elect Donald Trump. A large deportation effort could impact Class B and C markets and workforce housing rentals, which are heavily occupied by immigrants. A mass deportation effort may harm the construction labor force throughout the country, and tariffs may balloon pricing for construction materials.

Nadji claimed retail and apartments are prospering, while office space is continuing to struggle. Optimism in the retail sector is reportedly at a 20-year high, as consumers have returned to stores. Affordability is at an all-time low, which results in a stronger demand for rental properties and apartments. (Source)



Discount Tire is planning renovations at its newly purchased site. Combined, the buildings total approximately 275.2KSF. - 7. NAI Legacy purchased the 14KSF former <u>CVS</u> at 10010 N. Scottsdale Road in Scottsdale for \$11.2M. NAI Legacy intends to spend an additional \$5M to redevelop the property into a pet hospital and ambulatory surgery center. VCA Animal Hospitals Inc., a subsidiary of Mars Inc., will then lease the property for 15 years. NAI's Michael Houge represented the buyer. David Buelow, a partner at Bridge Law Group and principal of NAI Legacy, managed the legal representation.
- 8. NAI Horizon's Mark and Larson Wilcke negotiated the sale of 4.81 acres for nearly \$3.3M. The two represented the seller, The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The property is located at the NWC of 206th Street and Riggs Road in Queen Creek. The buyer, Riggs Road, LLC, was represented by CT Realty's Christian C. Talbot.


